PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Welcome back!

Hi to all members old and new, I trust everyone is safe and well!

It is fantastic to be into the summer season already and boy have the last few weeks flown. There has been a flurry of activity going on in the background as we prepared for and move through the summer season. I'm very excited to report that O'Halloran Hill Tennis Club is now part of an elite group of sports clubs that have achieved 'StarClub' status! This is an immense achievement from initially signing up for the program some 7 years ago, we have collectively pushed through the barriers in the way of us completing this program. Once the grant programs re-open, this will see the club able to apply for and strengthen it's case for funding as we move forward.

The council have also begun (and by the time the newsletter goes out, almost finished) repairs to the raised cracks/sections to court 6. A smaller section of the same court was repaired 4 or so years ago and we are hopeful that this more significant repair lasts a little longer.

The committee have also now voted in for a solar system to be installed at the club. We will update further on this as the process unfolds further but this is a fantastic investment in the future sustainability of the club. At this stage the system will see us installing 54 panels on the roof, mainly on the East side of the club roof. We have opted for Australian made 'Tindo' panels and the system output estimates show us as producing somewhere in the region of 27,000 kilowatts through the system yearly. With our electricity need being very specific, we have not optioned a battery system at this time and see this as a future expansion once the 3-phase battery technology has caught up (which should be in the very near future).

Whilst we are still under some operating restrictions, we are currently looking at how we can run our Christmas party. Though this may take a slightly different form this year it will be fantastic to get everyone together as we come up to the break and Christmas period!

Hope to see you all at the Christmas party or out on the courts!

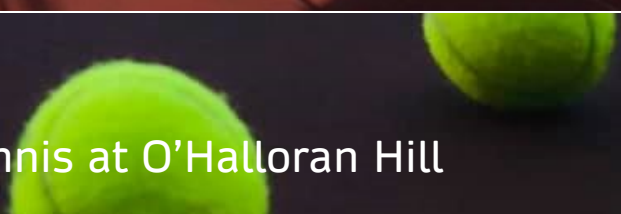
